1. Understand the Role of the ONT Fiber optic internet requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals from the fiber into electrical signals that your device can use . 3. Choose the Right Fiber Cable Select single-mode or multi-mode fiber depending on distance and speed requirements. For outdoor runs, consider direct-burial fiber or conduit for protection . Avoid sharp bends and secure the cable with clips or conduit to prevent damage . 4. Terminate and Test the Fiber Use a fiber termination kit to attach connectors (LC, SC, etc.) to the fiber ends. Ensure the connectors are clean and properly seated to avoid signal loss . Test the connection with a visual fault locator or OTDR if available. 5. Optional: Use a Switch for Multiple Devices If you need to connect multiple devices without a router, you can attach a Gigabit Ethernet switch to the media converter or ONT. This allows multiple devices to share the fiber connection while still bypassing a traditional router .
