What It Is

A Router Mode ONU (Optical Network Unit) is a device designed for Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) connections. It performs two main functions: converting the fiber optic light signal from your ISP into digital data and managing your home network, including routing, firewall protection, and Wi-Fi access . This eliminates the need for separate ONT and router devices, simplifying setup and saving space.

- o Wi-Fi Standard: Wi-Fi 6 is sufficient for most homes, Wi-Fi 6E adds a 6 GHz band for dense areas, and Wi-Fi 7 can fully utilize 2+ Gbps fiber lines .
- o Number of Ports: More Ethernet ports allow multiple wired connections; consider LAN aggregation if you need higher throughput .
