

Fiber optic module plugged into the switch

Article Overview

A fiber optic module (SFP or SFP+) can be directly connected to a switch using duplex fiber cabling or pre-terminated direct attach cables, ensuring proper module type and LC connector alignment.

Choosing the Right SFP Module

To connect a fiber optic module directly to a switch, you must select an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceiver compatible with your switch and network requirements. Key considerations include:

- o Fiber type: Single-mode (OS2) for long distances or multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances .
- o Bandwidth: 1G modules are SFP, 10G modules are SFP+, and higher speeds use QSFP .
- o Connector type: Most modern SFP modules use duplex LC connectors .
- o Compatibility: Use manufacturer-approved transceivers to avoid unpredictable behavior or link instability .

Cabling Options

There are two main ways to connect the module to the switch:

- o Duplex Fiber Patch Cables: Pre-terminated fiber cables with LC connectors on both ends. Ensure the send and receive fibers are crossed between the two switches (A to B, B to A), .
- o Direct Attach Cables (DACs): Pre-terminated cables with SFP connectors on each end. These are suitable for short distances and eliminate the need for separate fiber and transceivers .

Installation Steps

- o Insert the SFP module into the switch port until it clicks securely.
- o Connect the duplex fiber patch cable or DAC to the module.
- o Verify that the send and receive fibers are correctly aligned.
- o Check the switch interface for link status and ensure the module is recognized by the switch operating system .

Additional Considerations

- o Network topology: Star or daisy chain topologies are common; ensure the switch has enough SFP ports for your design .
- o Distance and signal loss: Single-mode fiber supports longer distances, while multimode is limited to shorter runs.
- o Safety: Avoid direct eye exposure to fiber optic lasers during installation .
- o Troubleshooting: If the link does not come up, verify module compatibility, fiber type, and connector
