An ST fiber optic patch cord uses a Straight Tip (ST) connector with a push-and-twist bayonet coupling, commonly used for high-speed data and telecom connections.

Overview

An ST-ST fiber optic patch cord is a cable assembly with ST connectors at both ends, designed to connect network devices, optical transceivers, or terminal boxes for signal routing . The ST connector, short for Straight Tip, features a cylindrical ferrule with a bayonet-style twist lock, allowing quick insertion and secure locking to prevent accidental disconnection . This type of patch cord is widely used in telecom, datacom, LANs, optical fiber communication systems, and cable TV networks .

Construction

The patch cord consists of two main components:

- o Optical Fiber Cable: Can be single-mode (9/125 μm) or multimode (50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm), with a glass core, cladding, and protective outer jacket .
- o Connector Kit: Includes the ST connector housing and ceramic ferrule, which ensures precise alignment and low signal loss. The ST connector is standardized under IEC 61754-2 . The cable may also include Kevlar reinforcement and a PVC or plenum-rated outer sheath for durability and safety in indoor installations .

Features

- o Bayonet mount with push-in and twist mechanism for secure connections .
- o Low insertion loss, typically $\leq 0.2\text{--}0.3$ dB, ensuring high-speed data transmission .
- o Durable construction resistant to pulls, snags, and impacts during installation .
- o Available in simplex or duplex configurations and can be customized for riser or plenum applications .

- o Connecting optical transceivers to patch panels
- o Data centers and enterprise networks
- o Telecom and CATV systems
- o Optical test equipment and lab setups They are particularly suitable for internal network use where high-speed, low-loss connections are required .
