- o Steel trays are commonly used due to their strength and durability. However, hot-dip galvanized steel offers limited fire resistance because the zinc coating melts at relatively low temperatures, making it suitable only for low-risk areas .
- o Stainless steel trays provide structural integrity under heat but do not inherently prevent fire spread, so they are better for corrosion-prone environments rather than fire-sensitive areas .
- o Fire-coated steel trays are ideal for high-risk areas, as the coating forms an insulating layer during a fire, significantly reducing fire spread .
- o Aluminum trays are lightweight and corrosion-resistant but are less suitable in fire-sensitive environments due to lower heat tolerance .

Installation and Firestopping

Proper installation is crucial for fire safety. Key practices include:

- o Layered fire blocking: Fireproof materials should be placed layer by layer to create a compact barrier around cables .
- o Fireproof mortar filling: Gaps between cables, trays, and fire-blocking materials should be filled uniformly to prevent fire and smoke penetration .
- o Sealing wall and slab penetrations: Openings where trays pass through walls or floors must be tightly sealed with fire-rated boards, firestop packs, or mineral wool to maintain fire integrity .
- o Correct sizing of openings: Ensure openings are appropriately sized to allow effective sealing and prevent gaps that compromise fire protection .

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Regulatory Guidance

The NEC Article 392 provides guidance on cable tray selection, installation, and support, emphasizing that trays must be robust and suitable for the type of wiring they carry . While low-voltage cables may not carry high current, fireproof trays are recommended in areas where fire risk is significant or where continuity of service is critical.

For low-voltage wiring, fireproof cable trays should be used in high-risk or fire-sensitive environments to protect cables, prevent fire spread, and ensure system reliability. Material choice, proper installation, and adherence to firestopping standards are essential to maximize safety and compliance .
