- o Technical and Contractual Agreements: Developers must negotiate the PTF (Point de Livraison Technical Framework) with Enedis, which defines network works, cost allocation, and connection timelines .
- o Integration with Energy Storage: The distribution box ensures that energy flows comply with grid requirements while maximizing self-consumption and backup capabilities .
