



Grounding wire of surface-mounted electrical box

The grounding wire, known as the equipment grounding conductor, provides a path of minimal resistance for the fault current. This low-impedance path causes the circuit breaker to trip almost instantaneously, de-energizing the metal box. Page top photo: ground wire for the. Install grounding wire to provide current with alternate paths to avoid electrical shocks in case of power surges. Run ground wires parallel to hot and neutral wires in a branch circuit.
