For most homes, the standard height is around 1.5 meters (about 5 feet) from the ground. This height is comfortable for most people to access without straining. It also keeps the box out of reach of small children, adding an extra layer of safety. In the 1999 NEC, a new subsection covered working space height. The requirement was changed to permit other equipment associated with the electrical installation to be installed above or below the

The materials, design and construction of manholes, handholes, subsurface equipment enclosures, and other underground boxes shall be such as to provide sufficient strength to sustain, with a suitable

This guidance is aimed at those responsible for planning and subsequent management, and those who control the installation and use of electrical systems and equipment on construction sites.
