- o **Alignment:** Use horizontal justification settings to align the tray sections properly. The opening should be centered or offset according to design requirements, ensuring smooth cable routing ().
- o **Spacing and Support:** Maintain recommended rung or support spacing (typically 150-230 mm for ladder trays) to prevent cable sagging near the opening ().
- o **Cable Protection:** Edges of the opening should be smooth or fitted with grommets to prevent cable damage. For solid or ventilated trays, consider covers or guards if the opening exposes cables to environmental hazards.

Standards and Best Practices

- o Follow National Electrical Code (NEC) and manufacturer guidelines for tray modifications and openings ().
- o Ensure that any horizontal opening does not interfere with grounding, bonding, or electromagnetic interference (EMI) shielding if applicable.
- o Plan openings during the design phase to minimize on-site modifications and maintain aesthetic and functional consistency.
