Home electrical distribution boxes vary by type, but typical dimensions range from 200x200x120 mm for small wall-mounted units to larger multi-gang or power distribution boxes, with depth often critical for wire fill and future expansion.

Standard Types and Dimensions

Single-gang boxes are the most common for one switch or outlet, typically around 2" x 3" x 3.5" (50x75x90 mm), providing at least 18 cubic inches of internal volume for wiring clearance. Multi-gang boxes accommodate multiple switches or outlets in one location. Width is calculated by summing the widths of individual switches plus additional spacing (usually 20 mm per side), height is switch height plus 40 mm, and depth is maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. Junction boxes protect wire splices and branch connections. Common sizes are 4" x 4" (100x100 mm) with variable depths from 1.5" to 3.5" (38-90 mm), depending on wire count and conductor volume. Power distribution boxes for larger loads or main breaker panels require more space. Wall-mounted units often range from 200x200x120 mm up to 800x600x300 mm, while freestanding cabinets can be 1600-2200 mm high, 600-1800 mm wide, and 300-600 mm deep. Depth is especially important to accommodate bending radius of incoming wires and terminal connections.
