- o KwikRail System: Aluminum trays with I-beam side rails, designed for commercial and light industrial applications. NEMA class 12A and 12B trays allow easy modification of rungs and support a variety of cable loads .
- o Perforated or Wire Mesh Trays: Depth and thickness may differ, but the nominal width remains 12 inches. These trays are often used for lighter cable loads or where ventilation is critical .

Installation Notes

- o Ensure the tray is supported on spans shorter than or equal to the tray length to prevent excessive deflection .
- o Consider the NEC fill capacity and heat dissipation when selecting depth and spacing. Wider trays often provide better airflow and easier cable pulling than simply increasing depth .
- o Material choice (steel vs. aluminum) affects load capacity, corrosion resistance, and long-term durability .
