

How many centimeters is the fiber optic spool

A standard four-inch fiber optic spool holds up to 85,000 centimeters of bare fiber, while a five-inch spool can hold up to 450,000 centimeters.

Fiber optic spools are designed to store long lengths of optical fiber safely and efficiently. For example, a four-inch diameter spool typically holds up to 850 meters of bare fiber, which converts to 85,000 centimeters. Larger spools, such as five-inch diameter spools, can hold up to 4.5 kilometers of bare fiber, equivalent to 450,000 centimeters . - o Bend radius and tensile strength: Proper winding ensures the fiber is not damaged, which may slightly reduce the maximum length that can be safely stored .

They may come with or without connectors, and some spools include protective enclosures to prevent damage during handling . When planning installations, converting the fiber length to centimeters can help in precise measurement and inventory management.
