The majority of the sections have a length of 3 meters, as this is easy to transport and can be compactly placed on the shipping trucks. Fill Ratio is the allowable percentage of the tray to be filled with cables, typically around 40% to 50% for safety and airflow. Cable. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements --width, depth, length, and material thickness--that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. IEC 61537 covers cable tray and cable ladder systems for the support and accommodation of cables, while NEC Article 392 governs cable.
