Key Factors Affecting Fiber Array Pricing

- o **Fiber Count and Array Type** The number of fibers in an array significantly impacts cost. - o **Environmental and Material Considerations** Outdoor or harsh-environment arrays may require armored fibers, UV-resistant jackets, or flame-retardant materials, which increase material and production costs. Indoor arrays with standard PVC or LSZH jackets are generally cheaper .
- o **Market and Production Factors** Production complexity, such as multi-fiber alignment and packaging, can be a major cost driver. Approximately 31% of manufacturers report production cost challenges due to these factors. Emerging technologies like silicon photonics integration can also affect pricing by improving precision but adding initial development costs .

Typical Pricing Ranges

While exact prices vary by supplier and specifications, indicative unit costs for fiber optic cables and arrays are:

- o Simplex/Duplex Indoor Cable: \$0.05 - \$0.30 per meter
 - o Single-mode Outdoor Cable: \$0.10 - \$0.50 per meter
 - o Multimode (OM1/OM2/OM3): \$0.10 - \$0.60 per meter
 - o Armored Cable: \$0.30 - \$1.00 per meter
