

How to connect a Layer 3 switch to a fiber optic cable

- o Configure the Switch: Set the port to fiber mode if required, and configure network parameters such as VLANs, IP addresses, or routing settings for Layer 3 functionality .
- o Test the Link: Verify connectivity and link speed using switch diagnostics or network monitoring tools.

- o Distance and Fiber Type: Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) is suitable for distances up to a few hundred meters, while single-mode fiber (OS2) supports several kilometers .
- o Bandwidth Matching: Ensure the SFP module's speed matches the switch port and network requirements .
- o Topology: For multiple switches, consider star or daisy-chain topologies to optimize performance and reduce congestion .
