

How to connect a router's optical port to a fiber optic cable

You connect a fiber optic cable to your router by first linking it to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal to Ethernet, and then connecting the ONT to your router's WAN port.

 - o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .
- ### 5. Configure the Router
- o Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1).
 - o Enter ISP credentials if required.
 - o Update firmware to ensure optimal performance and security .
- ### 6. Verify Connection
- o Connect a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet.
 - o Run a speed test to confirm fiber speeds.
 - o If there's no connection, reboot the ONT and router or contact your ISP for support .

- o Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets.
 - o Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply to prevent signal loss.
 - o Use high-quality Ethernet cables to maintain maximum speed .
