

How to connect broadband to a fiber optic cable

To connect broadband using fiber optic cable, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert light signals into data, then link it to a compatible router via Ethernet.

- o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes), .

Step 4: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- o Position the router strategically to optimize Wi-Fi coverage and update firmware for best performance .

Step 5: Optimize Your Network

- o Place the router in a central location to reduce dead zones.
- o Secure your network with strong passwords and updated firmware.
- o Consider Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6e routers for higher speeds and lower latency .
