- o Retail prices range from \$1 to \$6 per linear foot, depending on fiber count, type (single-mode or multimode), and jacket construction .
 - o Wholesale bulk purchases can be as low as \$0.09 to \$1.52 per foot.
 - o Simple 1-core FTTH drop cables cost around \$0.13 per foot, while high-count backbone cables (e.g., 288 strands) can reach \$6 per foot or more .
- Installation Costs:
- o Home installations typically range from \$1,500 to \$7,000, averaging around \$4,500, depending on cable length, installation method, and labor rates .
 - o Aerial installation costs \$6.55-\$12 per foot, while underground trenching can cost \$15-\$35 per foot due to excavation and complexity .
 - o Large commercial or multi-building projects can cost tens of thousands of dollars, influenced by the number of drops, permits, and site preparation .

- o Permits may range from \$50 to \$500.
 - o Specialized equipment, routers, and ongoing maintenance should also be considered .
