Connect 16mm² ground cable to each troughBefore starting the installation of troughs, make sure that you have: . 100x35mm vertical cable trays for cable routing from the roof . 150x35mm horizontal troughs for cable routing between panels . Wood screws 4x30mm for fixing troughs . Yellow green cable LGY 16mm² for grounding . Solar return. An assembly of units/sections with associated fittings that form a rigid structural system to securely fasten or support cables. Think of a roadway bridge that supports traffic.
