

How to connect the equipment to the distribution box price

Connecting equipment to a distribution box involves proper wiring of phase, neutral, and earth lines through MCBs and RCCBs, ensuring safety and compliance, with costs varying by box type and installation complexity.

Steps to Connect Equipment

- o Select the Right Distribution Box Choose a box based on your environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check IP/NEMA ratings for protection against dust and water, and ensure the material (steel or plastic) suits your installation site .
- o Install the Box Safely Mount the box on a stable surface at an accessible height (~1.5m). Ensure it is level, ventilated, and, if outdoors, waterproof with a rain cover .
- o Prepare Wiring Strip insulation to the correct length for terminals. Arrange wires neatly, secure with zip ties, and leave space for heat dissipation .
- o Connect Input Power
 - o Connect the phase and neutral wires from the main supply to the Main MCB.
 - o Connect the output of the Main MCB to the RCCB for protection against leakage .
- o Connect Output Loads
 - o For single-pole MCBs, connect the phase wire from the RCCB output to the MCB input; neutral goes to the neutral link.
 - o For double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral from the RCCB output to the MCB input.
 - o Connect the earth wire from the supply and equipment to the earth link .
- o Test and Label Perform insulation resistance tests and check each circuit with a multimeter. Label all circuits for easy identification and future maintenance .

Price Considerations

- o Distribution Box: Residential single-phase boxes typically range from \$30 to \$150 depending on brand, material, and number of MCB slots. Industrial or commercial boxes can cost \$200-\$500 or more .
- o MCBs and RCCBs: Single-pole MCBs cost around \$5-\$15 each, double-pole MCBs \$15-\$30, and RCCBs \$20-\$50 depending on rating and brand .
