

How to connect the panel to the fiber optic interface for internet access

Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2-5 minutes .

Step 5: Connect the Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port . Power on the router and access its admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) to configure your ISP credentials if required . Update firmware and enable security settings like WPA3 for Wi-Fi protection.

Step 6: Test the Connection



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Verify internet access by connecting a device to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. Run a speed test to ensure the fiber connection is performing as expected . If issues arise, reboot the ONT and router or contact your ISP for support.
