

How to drill holes for the top-in bottom-out electrical distribution box

Safety First

Before drilling, turn off all power to the panel and verify it is de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester. Wear safety glasses, gloves, and a face mask to protect against metal or plastic shavings and potential sparks. Ensure the panel is properly supported to prevent movement during drilling .

Choosing the Right Tools

- o Step drill bits are ideal for thin metal or plastic panels, allowing incremental sizing for clean holes without distorting the material .
- o Twist drill bits can be used but may grab and deform thin metal; use low RPM and apply coolant if drilling plastic .
- o Sheet metal hole punchers or knockout punches can also create precise holes, especially for larger diameters .

Hole Placement

- o For a top-in, bottom-out configuration, mark the entry and exit points for cables, ensuring holes are at least 1 inch away from live components and 1/4 inch from breakers or fuses to comply with safety standards .
- o Avoid drilling above live parts in outdoor or wet-rated enclosures (e.g., 3R panels) unless using proper cable hubs .

Drilling Technique

- o Mark the hole location with a center punch to prevent the bit from wandering.
- o Secure the panel in a vice or clamp to prevent movement.
- o Drill slowly, especially with large-diameter bits, to avoid overheating or melting plastic.
- o Deburr the edges after drilling to ensure a smooth surface for cable glands or connectors.

Installing Cable Glands

- o Select cable glands that match the drilled hole size (e.g., M20 clearance holes typically require 20-22 mm diameter) .
- o Most cable glands come with nuts, so threading the hole is usually unnecessary.
