When fastening the cover, ensure that any metallic fasteners maintain electrical continuity between the cover and the tray, or use dedicated grounding clamps if required . Avoid bare copper in aluminum trays to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors with exposed bonding points are recommended .

- o Ensure covers are securely attached to prevent accidental displacement, which could expose cables to damage or create tripping hazards.
