

How to fix indoor fiber optic cables

Indoor fiber optic cable repairs are generally limited to replacing pre-terminated patch cords or rerouting damaged sections, while full fiber splicing requires professional intervention.

Safety First

Fiber optic cables carry invisible laser light and contain microscopic glass fibers that can cause serious eye injury or skin irritation. Always wear safety glasses with side shields and gloves when handling damaged cables to prevent exposure to laser light and glass splinters .

Identifying the Problem

Check the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) for status lights. A red or blinking light usually indicates a loss of optical signal, confirming a cable issue. Visually inspect the cable for cuts, crimps, or crushed sections, and note any areas where the cable is sharply bent. Indoor fiber should maintain a bend radius no tighter than the circumference of a coffee mug .

Minor Indoor Fixes

- o Reroute the cable along a smoother path if it is tightly bent or stressed. Secure it with electrical tape or soft Velcro ties, avoiding direct pressure on damaged areas .
- o Replace pre-terminated patch cords (jumper cables) connecting the main line to the ONT. Ensure the replacement matches the connector type (e.g., SC/APC or LC) and polish type. This is the safest repair a homeowner can perform without specialized equipment .
