

How to install a distribution box in a small building

Step 4: Install the Box

Place the distribution box on the prepared base and secure it with screws, making sure it is level and stable . Leave space for heat dissipation and maintenance.

Step 5: Wire Preparation and Connection

- o Cut and strip wires to the appropriate length, exposing the conductor.
- o Connect input and output wires: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following standard color codes .
- o Install circuit breakers according to the building's electrical load. Each circuit should have its own protection device, such as a breaker or fuse .
- o Route wires neatly inside the box and secure them with cable ties to prevent tangling and ensure proper ventilation .
