

How to install cable trays through roofs

Rooftop cable tray installation requires proper support, secure anchoring, grounding, and careful planning to withstand environmental conditions and ensure safe cable management.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations, ensuring no clashes with other services and maintaining adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance. Inspect all materials for damage and verify that they meet project specifications. Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports to prevent warping or moisture damage.

Support Systems

Cable trays on rooftops must be supported to handle weight, wind loads, and thermal expansion. Use support legs, bases, and horizontal bracing according to design specifications. Supports should maintain trays level, prevent sagging, and distribute weight evenly. Center-hung tray supports can simplify installation and allow cables to be deposited from both sides, with maximum load capacities typically ranging from 318 kg to 340 kg per hanger and support spacing up to 3.6 m.

Installation Steps

- o Vertical Trays: Install vertical trays first, typically on the far side of the planned installation. Secure them to counter-laths or structural elements with screws spaced 150-200 mm apart, leaving a gap of about 300 mm from the top and bottom.
- o Horizontal Trays: Mount horizontal trays under junction boxes or along planned cable routes, maintaining proper spacing and clearance from edges. Connect horizontal trays to vertical trays and ensure electrical continuity for grounding.
- o Anchoring and Bracing: Attach support legs to bases with bolts and nuts, and add horizontal bracing approximately 3/4 of the support height. Double or triple bracing may be required in designated locations.
- o Grounding: Connect all trays to a grounding system using appropriate cables (e.g., 16 mm² yellow-green wire) to ensure safety and compliance.

Environmental Considerations

Rooftop trays are exposed to UV radiation, temperature fluctuations, wind, and precipitation. Supports and trays must accommodate thermal expansion and contraction and be securely anchored to prevent dislodging during high winds or heavy snow. Properly supported trays also reduce strain on cables, prevent sagging, and facilitate maintenance.

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Final Checks

After installation, verify:

- o Stability and alignment of all trays and supports
- o Correct spacing of screws and bolts
- o Electrical continuity and grounding connections
- o Level and even distribution of weight across the system
