- o Heating Elements For extreme cold, consider low-wattage thermostatically controlled heaters inside the box to prevent condensation and freezing of components.
- o Proper Ventilation and Drainage Include drainage holes at the bottom and ventilation vents with filters to prevent water accumulation and allow moisture to escape, reducing ice formation .
- o Elevate the Box Mount the box slightly above ground level to avoid contact with snow or standing water, which can freeze and compromise the enclosure.
