

How to mount the optical distribution box on a pole

Article Overview

A pole-mounted optical distribution box is installed by securely attaching the mounting hardware to the pole, lifting the cabinet into position, and connecting fiber cables while following strict safety procedures.

Step 1: Prepare the Pole and Mounting Hardware

- o Ensure the pole is structurally sound and positioned in a location that allows safe access and proper cable routing .
- o Use the mounting hardware kit provided with the distribution box. Attach the mounting bracket to the pole according to the manufacturer's instructions .
- o Install the top angled support bars and safety loops using the specified bolts, washers, and lock nuts to provide stability and a secure attachment point for the cabinet .

Step 2: Safety Precautions

- o Always wear a safety harness attached to the cabinet's safety loops when working above ground .
- o Ensure a crane or hoist capable of lifting the cabinet's weight is available, and that stabilizers are properly positioned .
- o Avoid overhead obstructions and power lines during installation .

Step 3: Lift and Mount the Cabinet

- o Use a crane or hoist to lift the cabinet to the desired height next to the pole .
- o Hang the cabinet on the mounting bracket and secure the top using the angled support brackets .
- o Double-check that all bolts and fasteners are tightened and that the cabinet is stable before proceeding.

Step 4: Fiber Cable Management

- o Route the feeder cables from the aerial network into the distribution box, ensuring no excessive bending or pulling that could damage the fibers .
- o Use splice trays or cassettes inside the cabinet to organize and protect fiber splices .
- o Leave sufficient cable reserves in a figure-eight or circular pattern to allow future maintenance .
- o Connect drop cables to the pre-terminated ports for customer connections, ensuring proper labeling and clean connections .

Step 5: Final Checks

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- o Inspect all connections for alignment, cleanliness, and damage .
 - o Ensure the cabinet door is securely closed and locked to protect the fibers from environmental exposure .
 - o Verify that the cabinet is firmly mounted and that all safety measures remain in place before leaving the site.
- By following these steps, a pole-mounted optical distribution box can be safely and efficiently installed, providing a reliable point for fiber distribution and customer connections.
