Effective PDU planning ensures reliable, scalable, and efficient power distribution to all IT equipment in a data center.

Assess Power Requirements

Start by calculating the total power draw of all IT equipment in each rack, including servers, storage, and networking devices. Use the rated power in watts (W) or kilowatts (kW) for each device and sum them to determine the baseline requirement. Consider rack density and future growth--if you plan to add high-performance GPUs or additional servers, size PDUs to accommodate that expansion to avoid costly upgrades later .

Choose the Right PDU Type

PDUs range from basic units to intelligent or switched models:

- o Basic PDUs: Provide reliable power distribution without monitoring; suitable for simple setups .
- o Metered PDUs: Include power meters to monitor real-time consumption, aiding energy efficiency and capacity planning .
- o Switched/Intelligent PDUs: Allow remote control of individual outlets, scheduled power cycling, and environmental monitoring, which is critical for uptime and troubleshooting .

Plan for Redundancy

Implement redundant power feeds (A+B configuration) to ensure continuous operation if one PDU or power source fails. Redundancy is especially important for high-demand equipment like GPU servers or critical storage systems .

Integrate with Data Center Power Architecture

PDUs are the final distribution point in the power chain. Typical architecture:

- o Utility supply -> medium-voltage switchgear
 - o MV/LV transformer -> low-voltage switchboards
 - o UPS (if used) -> PDUs/busways -> rack power
- Modern designs may use higher distribution voltages directly to racks to reduce conversion losses and improve efficiency, as seen in Google and Microsoft data centers .
