

How to reconnect a broken fiber optic cable in a router

- o A solid green light on the ONT usually indicates proper power and signal reception .

- o Use a computer or mobile device to verify internet access.
- o Optionally, use network testing tools like a visual fault locator or OTDR to check signal integrity if issues persist .

- o Keep the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near a power outlet.
- o Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius.
