

How to remove the cage for a pluggable optical module

Use the bail latch to carefully pull the SFP module out of its cage on the optical interface. Because all the SFP optical modules support these monitoring functions, eSFP is also called SFP. 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When removing a CFP optical module, loosen the two screw rods of the module and then remove the module slowly. Do not directly drag the optical fiber to pull out the optical module or forcibly pull out

Open the bail latch until it is perpendicular to the face of the SFP module. Use the bail latch to carefully pull the SFP module out of its cage on the optical interface. Make sure you apply the extraction force

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Insert a dust plug into the optical ports of the SFP module to keep the optical interfaces clean. If the module has a bale-clasp latch, pull the bale out and down to eject the module.
