To set up a fiber optic router, connect the fiber line to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), then link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and configure your network for optimal performance.

- o Select the correct connection type (usually DHCP or PPPoE, as specified by your ISP) and verify compatibility with the ONT .
- o Update the router firmware to the latest version for security and performance .
