

How to thread fiber optic cables quickly

Using fiber optic fast connectors (mechanical splicing) is the quickest way to thread and terminate fiber optic cables in the field.

Mechanical Fast Connectors

Mechanical fast connectors allow rapid termination without the need for a fusion splicer. They are ideal for field installations, emergency repairs, or situations where speed is critical . The process generally involves:

- o Stripping the Cable: Remove the outer jacket and protective layers using a fiber stripper, exposing the bare fiber .
- o Cleaning: Wipe the bare fiber with a lint-free cloth and anhydrous alcohol to remove dust and oils .
- o Cutting/Cleaving: Use a fiber cleaver to cut the fiber to the correct length and ensure a smooth end face .
- o Inserting into Connector: Thread the fiber into the fast connector body, often bending it slightly to fit into the ferrule or pre-embedded section .
- o Securing and Testing: Crimp or screw the connector housing, then test the connection with an optical fiber test pen to ensure proper signal transmission .

Types of Fast Connectors

- o Straight-through connectors: Require precise fiber cutting and operator skill; faster than fusion but sensitive to end-face quality .
- o Pre-embedded connectors: Include a pre-polished fiber section and index-matching gel, reducing the need for precise cleaving and operator skill, making them faster and easier to install .

Fusion Splicing

Fusion splicing provides the lowest signal loss and is ideal for permanent installations, but it is slower and requires specialized equipment . Steps include stripping, cleaning, cleaving, aligning fibers in a fusion splicer, and applying an electric arc to fuse the fibers. While highly reliable, it is less practical for rapid field deployment due to setup time and equipment weight.

Tips for Speed

- o Use pre-embedded fast connectors for the fastest field termination.
 - o Prepare all tools and cleaning materials in advance.
 - o Ensure accurate fiber length and clean end faces to avoid rework.
 - o Practice proper bending and insertion techniques to minimize fiber breakage .
