

How to turn on the fiber optic cable in a router

To activate a fiber optic connection, connect the fiber cable to an ONT, power it on, then link it to your router's WAN port and power on the router.

Step 1: Prepare Your Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Most fiber connections require an ONT provided by your ISP, which converts optical signals into electrical signals your router can use .
- o Fiber-Ready Router: Ensure your router has a WAN, SFP, or fiber port compatible with the ONT .
- o Fiber Optic Cable: Typically thin with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet Cable: To connect the ONT to the router .
- o Power Cords: For both the ONT and router .

Step 2: Connect the Fiber Cable to the ONT

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's line enters your home.
- o Carefully insert the fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated port. Ensure it clicks into place without forcing it, as improper seating can degrade the signal .
- o Plug in the ONT's power adapter and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize. A solid green or blue PON/Optical light indicates a successful connection .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN or Internet port .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a connection. The router may automatically detect the fiber connection, or you may need to access its web interface (usually via 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to configure WAN settings according to your ISP .

Step 4: Verify the Connection

- o Check the ONT lights: Power should be solid green, and the PON/Optical light should be steady. Flashing or red lights indicate a problem with the fiber line .
- o Confirm the router's WAN/Internet light is active.
- o Test internet connectivity on a connected device.

Step 5: Optional Configuration

- o Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP or video conferencing to prioritize traffic .
- o Ensure your router firmware is up to date for optimal compatibility with fiber connections . By following



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these steps, your fiber optic cable should be fully activated, providing high-speed internet through your router. Proper handling and correct powering sequence are crucial for a stable and reliable connection.
