Methods of Fiber Optic Welding

- o **Mechanical Splicing** Mechanical splicing uses pre-fabricated connectors to align and hold fiber ends together without melting. While cheaper and simpler, mechanical splices are less durable and have higher signal loss over time . Tools like a visual fault locator may be required to verify alignment.
- o **Polishing and Gluing** This method involves cutting, polishing, and gluing fiber ends. It is inexpensive but time-consuming and less precise, making it suitable only for non-critical applications .

Steps for Fusion Splicing

- o **Prepare the Fiber:** Strip the protective coating and clean the fiber to expose the glass core.
- o **Cut the Fiber:** Use a precision cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end.
- o **Insert into Splicer:** Place fibers into the fusion splicer, which aligns them automatically or manually.
- o **Fuse the Fibers:** The splicer melts the fiber ends and joins them.
- o **Protect the Splice:** Place the welded fiber in a protective sleeve or distribution box to prevent mechanical damage .

Equipment and Prices

- o **Fusion Splicers:** Prices vary widely. Entry-level models start around \$2,000-\$5,000, while high-end automatic splicers can cost \$20,000-\$30,000 or more .
