

How to wire a freeze-proof and waterproof distribution box

Choosing the Right Enclosure

Select a waterproof and weather-resistant distribution box with an IP65-IP68 rating or equivalent NEMA 4/4X rating for outdoor use, which protects against dust, rain, and ice formation (). Materials like UV-stabilized ABS or polycarbonate are ideal for cold and sun-exposed environments, as they resist cracking and yellowing. Ensure the box has compression gaskets and secure latches to maintain a tight seal even after repeated openings ().

Preparing for Wiring
