Many countries, including the UK (BS-7671), China, Russia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Ukraine, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Israel, South Africa, Argentina. IEC 60445 (Basic and safety principle for interaction marking) defines three blue shades: CRITICAL: Light blue must NOT be used for DC- because it is reserved for AC neutral. Using light blue for DC- creates a shock hazard during maintenance. For AC power wiring within control panels (not cable. These directives are referred to as EN (European Norm) codes and are usually formulated in compliance with standards set by the International Organization for Standardization. These standards specify particular colors for wires to identify electrical conductors in both AC (Alternating Current) and DC (Direct Current) power circuits. While IEC 60204-1 provides international guidance and UL 508A specifies certain requirements, many manufacturers maintain proprietary color specifications. The primary international standard.
