It is the responsibility of management to ensure that all team members and supervisors are trained and familiar with applicable safe working practices, and that they take immediate and decisive action

After the fiber-optic cables are laid, the next step is splicing--joining individual fiber strands together. This process requires highly trained technicians using specialized equipment to ensure precise

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After cable pulling is completed and testing has been done, inspection to proceed for cable laying, cable tiles and back-filling. As per approved shop drawing warning tape shall be provided 300mm below

The procedure for stripping fiber optic cables is very similar to electronic cables. However, care should be taken not to cut into the layer of aramid directly beneath the jacket.

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
