

Install 2 distribution boxes

- o For a subpanel, install conduit from the main panel to the subpanel, using plastic bushings to protect wires from sharp edges ().

Wiring and Connections

- o Turn off power at the main breaker before starting any wiring ().
- o Strip wires to the correct length and connect phase wires to phase terminals, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground ().
- o Arrange wires neatly inside the box, using zip ties to prevent tangling and allow heat dissipation ().
- o Install circuit breakers or fuses appropriate for each load, including GFCI or AFCI protection where required ().

Testing and Safety Checks

- o Perform an insulation resistance test to ensure no short circuits ().
- o Use a multimeter to check that each circuit is functioning correctly before powering the system fully ().
- o Label all circuits clearly for future maintenance and safety ().
