Standard Dimensions

Cable trays are designed with width, height (depth), length, and material thickness in mind, all of which affect cable fill, heat dissipation, and structural support. Common standard widths include 100mm, 200mm, 300mm, and 450mm, while heights typically range from 25mm to 150mm depending on cable volume and ventilation requirements. Lengths are usually manufactured in straight sections for ease of installation, often around 3 meters per section. Material thickness varies by load capacity, with heavy-duty trays requiring 2.5mm or more and reinforced side rails for maximum support.

Calculating the Correct Tray Size

- o Determine total cable cross-sectional area: Sum the outer diameters of all cables to be routed from the distribution box.
- o Apply the fill ratio: NEC specifies 40% for power cables and 50% for control cables to ensure proper ventilation and prevent overheating.
- o Calculate required tray width: $\text{Tray Width} = \frac{\text{Total Cable Cross-Sectional Area}}{\text{Fill Ratio}} \times \text{Tray Height}$
- o Add spare capacity: Include 25% extra width for future expansion and easier cable pulling.
