- o Site Preparation: Inspect the area, clear obstructions, and verify civil and MEP clearances. Mark the tray route according to approved shop drawings .
- o Bracket Installation: Secure C-shaped brackets to the mounting surface using bolts, anchors, or clamps. Ensure brackets are level and spaced according to load requirements .
- o Tray Placement: Position the cable tray onto the brackets. For ladder or perforated trays, ensure rungs or perforations are properly supported by the bracket lips .
- o Fastening: Use bolts, nuts, or clamps to secure the tray to the bracket. Check for electrical continuity if required, using grounding jumpers or bonding points provided on the tray .
- o Alignment and Adjustment: Verify horizontal and vertical alignment, adjust as necessary, and ensure proper clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance .

- o Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray exits to prevent damage .
- o Ensure adequate ventilation for heat dissipation, especially in closed-bottom trays .

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o Follow EN, UL, or local electrical standards for structural integrity, grounding, and load capacity .
