

Installation of Cuban Galvanized Cable Trays

Article Overview

Cuban-style galvanized cable trays should be installed with proper planning, corrosion protection, secure support, and adherence to approved shop drawings to ensure safety and durability.

Material Selection and Preparation

Use galvanized steel cable trays to resist corrosion, especially in humid or outdoor environments. Galvanization provides a protective zinc layer that forms a patina over time, preventing rust and extending tray life . Inspect all trays, fittings, and accessories upon delivery to ensure they match approved material submittals and are free from damage . Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of about 1 meter, protecting them from moisture and direct sunlight .

Planning and Layout

Review the approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations. Mark horizontal and vertical runs, ensuring proper clearance from other services and sufficient space for cable pulling and future maintenance . Plan for bends, branches, and offsets, coordinating with other MEP systems to avoid clashes.

Support and Mounting

Install supports using threaded rods, metal plugs, and 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels, maintaining a maximum spacing of 1.2 meters to prevent sagging . Provide additional support at bends, branches, and offsets. Ensure trays are level, straight, and securely fastened using connectors and fittings appropriate for galvanized steel . For long runs, consider using cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable laying and prevent coating damage .

Installation of Cables

Lay cables neatly within the trays, separating by voltage and function. Use cable ties or straps to organize cables, leaving slack for expansion and future adjustments . Avoid overloading trays to prevent overheating and maintain proper airflow.

Inspection and QA/QC

Supervisors should verify that all installation steps comply with the approved method statement and inspection checklist. Ensure all operatives have completed safety induction and are competent in handling galvanized trays . Inspect connections, supports, and tray alignment before energizing the system.

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Maintenance Considerations

Regularly inspect trays for signs of corrosion, mechanical damage, or loose fittings. Clean and tighten connections as needed to maintain structural integrity and electrical safety. Galvanized trays generally require minimal maintenance due to their protective zinc coating. By following these steps, Cuban-style galvanized cable trays can be installed safely, efficiently, and with long-term durability, ensuring reliable cable management in industrial or commercial installations.
