

Installation of a complete set of household lighting distribution boxes

A household lighting distribution box should be installed in a dry, accessible location, sized appropriately for the number of circuits, and equipped with proper protection devices to ensure safety and compliance with standards.

Choosing the Right Distribution Box

Select a box based on environment, load capacity, and durability. For indoor residential use, plastic or steel boxes are common, with steel offering higher durability and plastic being lighter for easier installation. Check the IP or NEMA rating to ensure protection against dust and moisture, especially if the box is near potentially damp areas .

Sizing the Box

For lighting circuits with incoming wire sizes less than 10 mm² and fewer than 20 switches, the box width should be the sum of switch widths plus 20 mm on each side, height as switch height plus 40 mm, and depth as maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. For more than 20 switches, consider two rows of switches with width calculated as the sum of switch widths plus 40 mm, height as switch height plus 40 mm, and depth as maximum switch depth plus 10 mm .

Placement and Accessibility

Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and easily accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Avoid areas near water, flammable, explosive, or corrosive substances. Ensure proximity to the main power supply for easier connection and maintenance .

Wiring and Protection

- o Install circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit.
- o Maintain neat cable management and proper insulation.
- o Include DIN rails or terminal blocks for organized wiring .

Compliance and Safety
