For example, in a single-phase home distribution board, the live (phase), neutral, and earth wires are connected to the corresponding terminals of the switch or breaker. Proper labeling and secure connections are essential to prevent loose contacts and ensure safety . 4. **Air Switch or Knife Switch Installation** In some industrial setups, air switches or knife switches are used for high-current circuits. These are mounted inside the distribution box and connected to the incoming power lines. They are often used in three-phase systems and require careful alignment and insulation to prevent accidental contact .

Additional Considerations

- o **Safety and Compliance:** Always follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and use UL/CE-certified switches .
 - o **Cable Management:** Maintain neat wiring with proper insulation, correct wire gauge, and secure grounding .
 - o **Protection Devices:** Each switch or circuit should have appropriate protection, such as fuses, MCBs, or RCDs .
 - o **Accessibility:** Install switches at a convenient height (typically around 1.5 meters) and ensure the box is in a dry, ventilated area .
 - o **Labeling:** Clearly label each switch to indicate the circuit it controls, which simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting .
- By combining DIN rail mounting, panel mounting, and proper terminal connections, switches can be installed safely and efficiently in distribution boxes for residential, commercial, or industrial applications.
