The correct installation sequence is: site preparation, distribution box mounting, internal component setup, cable routing, wiring connections, and final inspection.

Step 1: Pre-Installation Preparation

- o Site Survey: Choose a dry, ventilated location away from flammable, corrosive, or explosive materials. Ensure accessibility for maintenance and future upgrades .
- o Box Selection: Confirm the type (residential, commercial, industrial), size, and load capacity based on electrical requirements .
- o Tools and Materials: Prepare screwdrivers, wire strippers, multimeter, insulation tester, circuit breakers, wires, ties, and insulating tape .

Step 2: Mounting the Distribution Box

- o Positioning: Install the box at an appropriate height (typically 1.5 meters for residential setups) and ensure it is securely fixed .
- o Clearance: Leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation and maintenance .
- o Protection: For outdoor or humid environments, ensure waterproofing or use protective covers .

Step 3: Installing Internal Components

- o Circuit Breakers and Terminal Blocks: Arrange breakers from left to right, reserving space on the right for future expansion .
- o DIN Rails and Busbars: Mount any additional devices or busbars as required for the system .

Step 4: Cable Routing and Wiring

- o Wire Specification: Select wire gauge according to load (e.g., 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for high-power circuits) .
- o Color Coding: Use standard colors--neutral (blue), phase A (yellow), phase B (green), phase C (red) .
- o Wiring Direction: Connect incoming main power to the left side of the box and route outgoing branch circuits to the right .
- o Connection Method: Connect each wire to the corresponding breaker or use parallel connections to simplify wiring .
- o Binding and Management: Secure wires with plastic ties, maintaining uniform spacing and straight runs for neatness and safety .

- o Inspection: Verify all connections, insulation, and grounding. Perform multimeter and insulation resistance tests .
- o Labeling: Clearly mark AC/DC circuits, voltage levels, and breaker functions for future reference .
