Importing drop cables and OS2 optical cables into Ireland requires electronic customs declaration via Revenue's AIS, proper documentation, and payment of applicable duties and VAT.

Key Requirements for Import

- o Customs Declaration All goods imported from outside the EU, including drop cables and OS2 optical cables, must have a customs declaration submitted electronically through the Revenue Automated Import System (AIS) by you or your agent .
- o Documentation Essential documents include:
 - o Commercial invoice detailing the product, its use, and composition clearly to avoid delays .
 - o Bill of lading or airway bill depending on the mode of transport.
 - o Packing list and insurance documents if applicable.
 - o Certificates of origin or other special certificates if required for specific goods .
