- o **Fiber Distribution Box:** Includes fiber splice trays, pigtails, adapters, and cable management features to maintain bend radius and protect fibers from physical damage and environmental factors .

- o **Junction Box:** Contains terminals or connectors for electrical wires, focusing on safety, insulation, and protection from moisture or dust, but lacks fiber-specific management features .
