DC and AC cables should be physically separated to reduce electromagnetic interference, and sharp bends or excessive tension must be avoided to protect insulation.

Code Compliance: NEC 2025 emphasizes mechanical protection, proper support spacing, and corrosion resistance for PV conductors in trays. Rapid shutdown and arc fault protection requirements must also be considered when routing cables. Metallic trays require proper grounding and bonding, while nonmetallic trays may need additional mechanical protection in exposed areas.

Environmental Considerations: PV cables are exposed to UV, moisture, temperature extremes, and vibration. Cable trays help mitigate these risks by providing stable support, reducing sagging, and protecting against environmental damage.
