Cabinet PDUs mount vertically in the back of a unit, offering up to 60 outlets without occupying rack space. Rackmount PDUs, on the other hand, fit horizontally within racks, typically providing 8 to 16 outlets. Vertical mounting, either along the side rails or at the rear of the enclosure. The data center has two main types of PDUs: floor PDUs and rack/cabinet PDUs (also known as "rack PDUs" or "rackmount PDUs"). When most people think of PDUs, they think of the rack/cabinet variety. PDUs are typically installed inside equipment racks or cabinets, where they distribute electrical power to servers, switches, storage devices, or industrial network components. The installation location should be determined according to the cabinet design, equipment layout, and power routing. Modern infrastructures typically rely on rack-level Power Distribution Units (PDUs), industrial CEE connectors, and structured cabinet designs to manage power connections efficiently. Unlike classic 19" PDUs, they do not require any height units (HU), thus creating more space for active components such as servers, switches, or storage systems.
