An LC-ST patch cord is a fiber optic cable with an LC connector on one end and an ST connector on the other. LC connectors are small form factor (1.25 mm ferrule) with a push-pull latch, ideal for high-density transceiver ports like SFP/SFP+ and QSFP, while ST connectors use a bayonet-style ferrule (2.5 mm) and are common in legacy or industrial networks . These cords are available in single-mode (OS2) and multimode (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5) variants, allowing compatibility with different network speeds and distances .
